Biznet Ready to Presents the Best Service for Delegates of APEC 2013

Jakarta, August 19th, 2013 – Various preparations to support the upcoming Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation Summit, or APEC 2013, at Nusa Dua - Bali in October 2013, are still being prepared.

Biznet Networks, as one of the leading fixed-line and multimedia telecommunication operators in Indonesia, is ready to provide ultra-fast Internet, Data Center, and Cable TV services at the event.

Adi Kusma, President Director of Biznet Networks, says that the preparation for APEC in terms of Fiber Optic infrastructure in Bali area, especially Nusa Dua, is now ready.

“Several buildings and convention centers are already connected by our network, which provides data communication, ultra-fast internet, and high definition quality Cable TV services,” he said.

In order to guarantee its internet security, Biznet has implemented Internet Protocol version 6 (IPv6), which is the newest generation for internet protocol to replace the previous version (IPv4). IPv6 has a more reliable security, and equipped with optional security IPSec developed by Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF). With IPSec, all incoming data into Biznet internet network can be encrypted so that the safety of the data can be ensured.

Adi explains that Biznet has recently owned huge Gbps (Gigabit per second) bandwidth capacity between Jakarta and Bali, and also more than 500 Kilometer (KM) of fiber optics networks in Bali area, therefore, Biznet is optimistic that the company will give the best solution for internet connection requirements during APEC. “As per now, our capacity is ready to be used,” he said.

Meanwhile, in order to be ready for unexpected occurrence during the summit, including internet connection disruption, Biznet has prepared a network that designed with built-in redundancy to minimize interruption potential that may occur. Our support team is ready 24/7,” he explained.

Adi also added that the needs for Internet in Bali will continue to grow due to Bali tourism market, which will continue to increase as shown by number of hotels and residences owned by foreigners that are growing from time-to-time, and predicted to continue to increase 30-40% every year.

In the future, Biznet will continue expanding its coverage area in Bali, whereas Biznet’s fiber optic network has already available in various locations, especially in main integrated tourism areas including BTDC, Nusa Dua, Denpasar, Tanjung Benoa, Jimbaran, Kuta, Legian, Seminyak, Sanur, Ubud, and Sayan. The development is planned to expand to Canggu, Brawa, and Uluwatu. Adi hopes by end of 2013, Biznet is able to expand the FO network up to 1,000 KM in Bali. “We continue to expand our network to new areas in Bali,” he said.
